- 5. What role did faithful men play in David's life (verse 6)?
- 6. At the end of the psalm, what was David's conclusion about who he would allow to influence him?

ON A DEEPER LEVEL

- 1. How would you describe your closest friends today? How do their priorities line up with your own? How do you know that a friend is influencing you negatively?
- 2. In what specific ways are your friends ministering to you these days?
- 3. Which particular character quality described in Psalm 101 inspire you personally? Why?
- 4. What specific indicators tell you that you need to break away from a friend or friends and find some new ones? What steps do you need to take to make the break?
- 5. What character qualities make you a positive influence on your friends? What about you is rubbing off on them?
- 6. Who in this group is influencing you? Which of their qualities are you absorbing?
